Volunteer Projects

Personal Care Drive

WDM Human Services' Food and Personal Pantry assists approximately 300 low-income households per month with personal care items. Organize a drive to collect personal care items for households in need including soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, laundry detergent, diapers, wipes, toilet paper, etc.

Socks & Underwear Drive

Collect new socks and underwear for children and adults.

Baby Supply Drive

Organize a "baby shower" to collect items needed for a baby: diapers, wipes, blankets, baby thermometers, baby clothing, diaper pails, baby bathtub, bottles, bath soap, baby lotion, baby fingernail clippers, feeding supplies, bibs, pacifier, baby bath towel and washcloth, etc.

Housewares Drive

Organize a drive to collect gently-used or new household items for the Clothing Closet including sheets, blankets, towels, lamps, kitchen items, small appliances (blenders, toasters, coffee pots, etc.).

Winter Apparel Drive

Organize a drive to collect gently-used or new winter coats, snow pants, hats, mittens, scarves and boots for all ages. Having a drive early in the season would really help!

School Supply Drive

Organize a drive to collect new school supplies for August distribution to low-income households. Volunteers are also needed to assist with the distribution in mid-August.

Toy Drive

Organize a drive to collect new, unwrapped toys for December distribution to low-income households. Volunteers are also needed to assist with the distribution in mid-December.

Clothing Drive

Organize a drive to collect gently-used clothing and shoes for all ages.
