West Des Moines City Council Proceedings Monday, November 2, 2015

Under Rule 12 of the Council Procedures, City Clerk Ryan Jacobson opened the regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of West Des Moines, Iowa, in the Council Chambers of the West Des Moines City Hall Monday, November 2, 2015 at 5:30 P.M. Council members present were: R. Messerschmidt, J. Sandager, K. Trevillyan, and R. Trimble.

City Clerk Jacobson introduced Boy Scout Troop 888.

Steve Gatton, Bicycle Advisory Commission member, stated the commission supports the adoption of the Bicycle Master Plan and Complete Streets Policy, which he believes would benefit the City, as seven of the eight healthiest cities and 13 of the 20 wealthiest cities in the United States have been designated as "Bicycle Friendly" communities.

The Mayor and Council expressed support for the Bicycle Master Plan and Complete Streets Policy and thanked the Bicycle Advisory Commission, Bicycle Task Force, and Parks and Recreation Advisory Board for their efforts in developing these proposed policies. The Council also requested that public education on the policies be carried out.

It was moved by Messerschmidt, second by Sandager to adopt Motion - Approval of Bicycle Master Plan.

Council member Trevillyan noted the proposed policy would serve as a guideline when developing new areas in the city, but the City will not be obligated to construct on-street bicycle facilities in areas where it would not be appropriate.
