West Des Moines City Council Proceedings Monday, July 11, 2016

Mayor Steven K. Gaer opened the regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of West Des Moines, Iowa, in the Council Chambers of the West Des Moines City Hall on Monday, July 11, 2016 at 5:31 PM. Council members present were: J. Mickelson, J. Sandager, and R. Trimble.

On Item 1. Agenda. It was moved by Trimble, second by Sandager approve the agenda as presented.

On Item 2. Public Forum

Ed Ames, 304 6th Street, reiterated the concerns about noise disturbance during events in Valley Junction that he had previously raised at the May 31, 2016 City Council meeting. He stated that he did not receive notification of the Valley Junction Events Advisory Committee meeting that was scheduled to discuss his concerns, however he did learn of the meeting from a friend. He attended the meeting, but he was not satisfied with the committee members' response to his concerns.

Clyde Evans, Community and Economic Development Director, reported that the Valley Junction Events Advisory Committee did take Mr. Ames' concerns into consideration, but their recommendation was to not limit the number of events and not require the stage to be relocated.

Mayor Gaer requested that staff place the matter on the agenda for the next City Council meeting for consideration.

Wendy Lacina, 537 2nd Street, stated her street is currently being reconstructed, and she complimented the contractor's work on that project; however, she noted the contractor damaged the water main stop box on her property, and she requested that the City ensure it gets repaired. She also reported she recently made a call to the Police Department, and she commended them for their professionalism.

Mayor Gaer inquired if staff plans to re-bid this project back in the future.

Gary Scott, Director of Parks and Recreation, responded staff is recommending the Council reject all bids because the bids came in significantly higher than the estimate, and the project would take 20 years to pay back the City's investment. He stated staff might recommend re-

bidding the project this upcoming winter. He noted staff did consider the possibility of redesigning the project to include a floating intake, but ultimately decided against that option. He also noted the City's agreement with West Des Moines Water Works for free water will expire in 2019, and West Des Moines Water Works intends for the City to begin paying for treated irrigation water at that time.

Mayor Gaer requested that staff place this matter on the agenda for an upcoming meeting of the Finance and Administration Subcommittee, as he believes it doesn't make sense for the City to use treated irrigation water at Raccoon River Park when water could be irrigated from Blue Heron Lake.

Council member Trimble noted the primary purpose of this budget amendment is the moving of positions from one cost center to another due to reorganization.
