West Des Moines City Council Proceedings Monday, August 22, 2016

Mayor Steven K. Gaer opened the regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of West Des Moines, Iowa, in the Council Chambers of the West Des Moines City Hall on Monday, August 22, 2016 at 5:30 PM. Council members present were: R. Messerschmidt, J. Mickelson, K. Trevillyan, and R. Trimble.

On Item 1. Agenda. It was moved by Trimble, second by Messerschmidt approve the agenda as presented.

Vote 16-326: Messerschmidt, Mickelson, Trevillyan, Trimble...4 yes Motion carried.

On Item 2. Public Forum

Eva Pratt, 4108 Timberwood Drive, spoke in favor of Consent Agenda Item 4(j) Approval of Deer Management Zone - 4105 and 4109 Quail Park Drive. She stated a 2016 report from the Polk County Deer Task Force indicated the Quail Park neighborhood has 98 deer per square mile, while the acceptable number in an urban setting is 30 deer per square mile. She noted the excessive deer population contributes to deer-vehicle accidents, ecological damage, declining deer health, and negative impacts to private property.

Council member Trimble stated he conducted an email survey of the Quail Park residents, and the responses were overwhelmingly in favor of the proposed deer management zone, so he supports the request.

On Item 3. Council/Manager/Other Entities Reports:

Fire Chief Craig Leu introduced Fire Lieutenants Derrik Bingham and Eric Brenneman, who were then sworn in by Mayor Gaer.

Council member Trimble reported the Finance and Administration Subcommittee met and discussed the proposed Raccoon River Park Softball Irrigation Modifications project, a proposal for year-round use of Valley View Aquatic Center, a proposed Community Housing Initiatives project, and the proposed redevelopment incentive policies. He also reported the City is working with other metro communities on a proposed "fair play" agreement.

Mayor Gaer stated he is a co-chair of the Greater Des Moines Partnership Development Council, and the existing "fair play" agreement is being discussed, and these discussions are being led by the Greater Des Moines Partnership economic development staff.

Council member Messerschmidt reported he attended a meeting of the Metro Advisory Council,

at which the proposed "fair play" agreement was discussed. He also reported the Public Works Subcommittee met and discussed ongoing construction projects and sidewalk issues near Jordan Creek Elementary School. He also attended a meeting of the Human Rights Commission and a meeting with the Greater Des Moines Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Iowa State Fair Board. He also reported he participated in a canoe tour of the Raccoon River that highlighted the potential for recreational opportunities along the waterway.

Council member Trimble stated this is the last Council meeting for Parks and Recreation Director Gary Scott, as he is retiring on August 31, 2016. The Mayor and Council expressed appreciation to Mr. Scott for his years of service and commended him for his many contributions to the community.
