Item: Amendment to City Code – Amend Title 9 (Zoning), Chapter 7 (Setback and Bulk Density Regulations) to update setback regulations pertaining to accessory structures in Residential Estate districts – City Initiated (AO-003767-2018)

Request Action: Recommend approval of an amendment to City Code

Case Advisor: Linda Schemmel, AIA 

Applicant's Request: The City of West Des Moines requests an amendment to Title 9 (Zoning) to update setback regulations pertaining to accessory structures.

- Title 9 (Zoning):
 - Chapter 7 (Setback and Bulk Density Regulations), Section 4 (Setback and Bulk Density Regulations), Table 7.6

These changes are intended to correct the required side yard setback for accessory structures in Residential Estate zoning districts. (See Attachment A, Exhibit A – Proposed Ordinance).

City Council Subcommittee: This item is scheduled to be discussed at the February 20, 2018, Development and Planning City Council Subcommittee.

Staff Review and Comment: There are no outstanding issues. Staff summarizes the following key points of interest:

Setback for accessory structures in Residential Estate zoning districts: A conflict existed in the zoning ordinance for the required side and rear yard setback distance for accessory structures in Residential Estate zoning districts. Table 7.6 in the Setback and Bulk Density Regulations noted incorrectly that accessory structure side and rear setbacks are five feet (5'), however the correct setback distance of twenty feet (20') is noted in the Accessory Buildings section of Chapter 14 (Accessory Structures). In a recent ordinance amendment to update accessory structure regulations (approved by City Council on September 18, 2017), the accessory structure setback information was removed from Chapter 14, but the corresponding correction to Table 7.6 was not included. This amendment corrects the setback information in Table 7.6.

Noticing Information: On February 7, 2018, notice of the February 12, 2018, Plan and Zoning Commission and February 20, City Council public hearings for this project was published in the *Des Moines Register*.

Staff Recommendation and Conditions of Approval: Staff recommends the Plan & Zoning Commission approve a resolution recommending to the City Council approval of the ordinance amendment.

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLAN AND ZONING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST DES MOINES, RECOMMENDING TO THE CITY COUNCIL THAT IT APPROVE AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 9 (ZONING), CHAPTER 7 (SETBACK AND BULK DENSITY REGULATIONS) TO UPDATE SETBACK REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO ACCESSORY STRUCTURES IN RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICTS.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF WEST DES MOINES, IOWA 2014 BY AMENDING TITLE 9 (ZONING), CHAPTER 7 (SETBACK AND BULK DENSITY REGULATIONS) TO UPDATE SETBACK REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO ACCESSORY STRUCTURES IN RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST DES MOINES, IOWA:

Section 1. Amendment. Title 9 (*Zoning*), Chapter 7 (*Setback and Bulk Density Regulations*), Section 4 (*Setback and Bulk Density Regulations*), Table 7.6, is hereby amended by deleting the highlighted strikethrough text and adding the text in bold italic:

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Savings Clause. If any section, provision, sentence, clause, phrase or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or part hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. Violations and Penalties. Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction shall be punished as set forth in Section 1-4-1 of the City Code of the City of West Des Moines, Iowa.

Section 5. Other Remedies. In addition to the provisions set out in the Violations and Penalties Section herein, the City may proceed in law or equity against any person, firm or corporation for violation of any section or subsection of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
