West Des Moines City Council Proceedings Monday, May 20, 2019

Mayor Steven K. Gaer opened the regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of West Des Moines, Iowa, in the Council Chambers of the West Des Moines City Hall on Monday, May 20, 2019 at 5:30 PM. Council members present were: J. Mickelson, K. Trevillyan, and R. Trimble.

On Item 1. Agenda. It was moved by Trimble, second by Trevillyan approve the agenda as presented.

On Item 2. Public Forum: No one came forward.

Council member Sandager arrived at 5:31 p.m., and Council member Hardman arrived at 5:33 p.m. The attendance was re-taken. Council members present were: R. Hardman, J. Mickelson, J. Sandager, K. Trevillyan, and R. Trimble.

Fire Chief Craig Leu reported that Deputy Fire Chief Matt Sonnenburg has earned the Chief Fire Officer designation from the Center for Public Safety Excellence. Mayor Gaer then presented the Chief Fire Officer plaque to Deputy Fire Chief Sonnenburg.

Council member Trimble reported the Finance and Administration Subcommittee met and discussed the JARCOR development project, an expansion of the "Go West" marketing campaign, and the purchase and rehabilitation of rental properties to be sold as affordable housing. The subcommittee also reviewed potential changes to the damaged mailbox policy and FY 2018-19 budget amendment #4. He also reported that the Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority (DART) has issued an RFP for a transit optimization study.

Council member Mickelson reported he saw the motorcade for an Honor Flight group travelling through West Des Moines earlier today, and he commended Hy-Vee and the West Des Moines Police Department for supporting this event.

Council member Hardman reported she attended the Citizen of the Year ceremony, where Mary Cole-Duvall and H. Milton Cole-Duvall were recognized as Citizens of the Year and Nick Brannen was recognized as Emerging Citizen of the Year. She also reported she attended a meeting of the Human Rights Commission, where discussion was held on the commission's strategic plan. She commended City Manager Tom Hadden for his involvement and leadership with the Human Rights Commission. She also attended the Police Week open house event, and she commended Police Chief Chris Scott and the Police Department staff for putting on a

successful event. She reported she also attended a meeting of the Valley Junction Neighborhood Association, where discussion was held on the potential paving of the unpaved alleys in Valley Junction and the upcoming Taste of the Junction festival.
