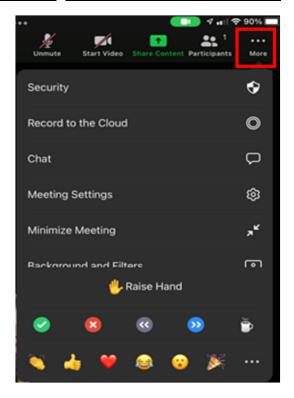

Intent:

- An evaluation of current regulations related to accessory uses and accessory structures was undertaken when questions arose on the proposed development of the Suite Shots indoor-outdoor golf driving range facility. The concern raised with the project was how to define the nets that enclose the driving range, and more specifically the poles that hold up the nets and what regulations should be applied.
- The proposed changes to city code are intended to clarify what is considered to be 'accessory' within a site and fencing regulations as they relate to recreation and sports related uses and facilities, as well as various other purposes of fences.
