ITEM: Legacy Woods, 2280 Grand Avenue – Accept a Master Plan for the development of the property– City of West Des Moines Parks and Recreation Department – MP-006429-2024

**Resolution: Approval of Master Plan** 

<u>Background</u>: The City of West Des Moines Parks and Recreation requests acceptance of a Master Plan for the approximately 22.8-acre property located at 2280 Grand Avenue. The Master Plan illustrates various program areas and will be complimentary to the Jordan House historic site.

### **Staff Review & Comment:**

- <u>History</u>: Past use of the property was a church camp. There have been several proposals over the years since the church camp no longer used the property; none have come to fruition. The City acquired the property in 2023. Discussion over use of the property culminated in the development of the Master Plan. The Master Plan illustrates intended development of the property as a passive park with an arboretum, heritage center, trails, picnic areas, and various structures.
- Key Development Aspects: Improvements to the property are intended to be handled via various private – public funding and agreements, with private donations being the main source of funding.

- 3. Landscape plantings, trails, and passive recreation areas will not be required to go through the Development Review process.

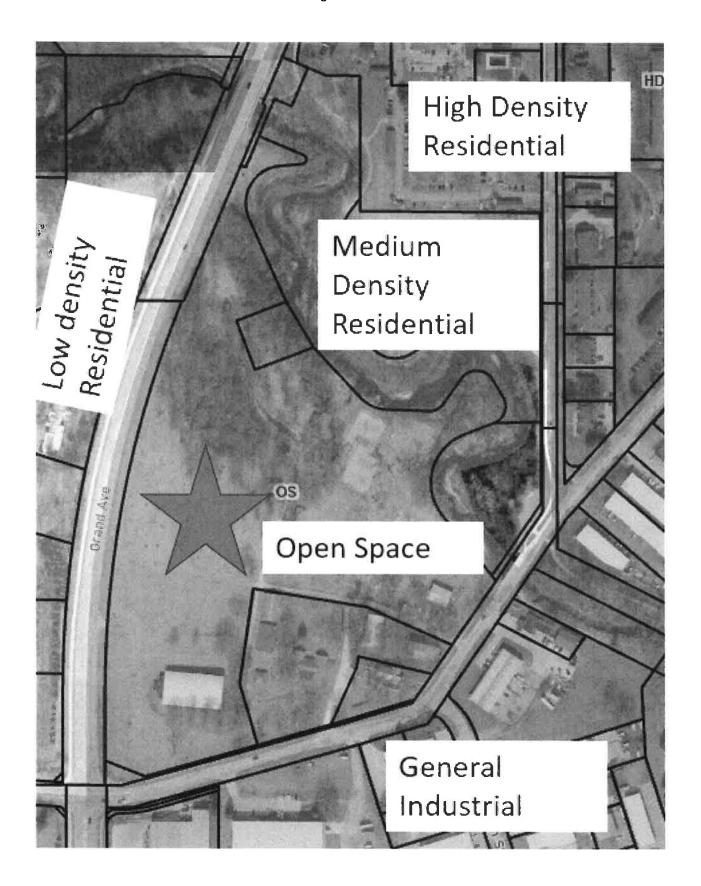
